Students soon will learn the importance of balancing personal finances through the newest Junior Achievement Discovery Center at Gwinnett.

Students are given adult profiles with a career, a salary, family obligations, homes and budgets to manage. They make purchasing and investment decisions, use banking services, buy insurance and juggle competing priorities while taking ownership for their personal financial success.

"Helping a teenager understand the importance of a budget is challenging at first, but as they go through the process, they begin to understand the financial trade-offs that come with their decisions," said Assurant Specialty Property president and CEO Gene Mergelmeyer, who will speak at Thursday's grand opening. "Junior Achievement's initiatives align closely with Assurant's values, and our employees are excited to volunteer and help students in Gwinnett as they've done downtown."
